

Adoption of IHRA Definition of Antisemitism Statement

SUMMARY

The University of Law Adopts IHRA Definition of Antisemitism in Full

The Executive Board and Academic Board of the University of Law voted overwhelmingly to adopt the International Holocaust Remembrance Association's working definition of antisemitism in full. The definition states that:

'Antisemitism is a certain perception of Jews, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jews. Rhetorical and physical manifestations of antisemitism are directed toward Jewish or non-Jewish individuals and/or their property, toward Jewish community institutions and religious facilities.'

The University has additionally committed to consulting on the adoption of other definitions that protect other minority groups who may feel vulnerable to discrimination and hatred.

All such definitions will be applied by the University with due regard to our responsibilities under the 2010 Equality Act, the University's Equality Diversity and Inclusion Policy, our commitment to freedom of speech and other relevant policies.
