### Guidance

As an indication of how the University's degree classifications for its LLB programmes may equate to classifications achieved at Canadian higher education institutions, the following information is provided.

University of Law LLB degree classification guidance

Mark Band used by the University of Law	University of Law Descriptor	University of Law Degree Classification Equivalent
70 and above	Excellent	1st
60 to 69	Very good	2.1
50 to 59	Good	2.2
40 to 49	Sufficient	Third Class
39 and below	Insufficient	Fail

For the purpose of admissions, the University of Law assess Canadian degree equivalency (generally) as follows.

UK Degree Classification	Indicative Canadian Equivalency
1st	3.7/4 or 10/12 or 8/9 or A or 80%
2.1	3.3/4 or 8/12 or 7/9 or B or 70%
2.2	2.7/4 or 6/12 or 5/9 or C or 60%
Third Class	2.3/4 or 4/12 or 4/9 or D or 50%
