

## Progression for September 2022 and January 2023 full-time PgDL and MA Law (Conversion) students

Due to the projected end date of our full-time on-campus or online Postgraduate Diploma in Law (PgDL) and Master of Arts in Law (MA Law Conversion) courses, you may not be eligible to commence our Bar Practice Course (BPC), LLM Legal Practice (SQE1&2) or SQE1 Preparation Course in September 2023.
